

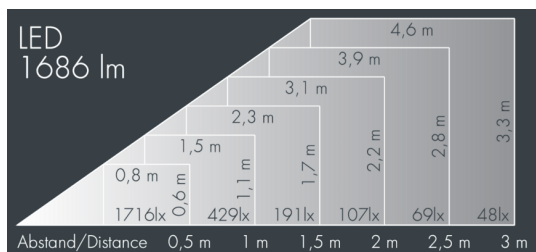


## Ecoline modular system luminaire, middle

housing made of extruded aluminum and corrosion-resistant die-cast aluminum AlSi12, polyester powder coated by high-quality and UV-stabilized coating process, Colour: white RAL 9002, all exterior parts are stainless steel, UV stabilised, impact-resistant polycarbonate cover with partial frosting for uniform light diffraction, silicon gasket, closure with 2 stainless steel screws, with stainless steel couplings on left and right side, tilt range: 220°, cable gland: M20, connecting terminal: 3 pole, highly efficient optics made of transparent thermoplastic for precise lighting tasks, CRI > 80, max 2 SDCM, service life L90/B10 > 50.000 h, luminous flux: 1686 lm, wattage: 23 W, delivered lumens 75 lm/W, protection type IP65, protection class I, impact resistance IK10, windage area 0,05 m<sup>2</sup>, dimensions (L×H×W): 942 × 58 × 54 mm, weight 2.9 kg
